- Appellation:** Toscana IGT
- Varietals:** 60% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Petit Verdot, 10% Merlot
- Color:** Vivid red with deeper hues
- Aroma:** Decisive but delicate aromas of wild laurel and liquorice root
- Taste:** Lively and rich with flavors of red fruits and spice intertwined with delicate oak influences
- Fermentation:** All varietals fermented separately in small tanks on the skins at a controlled temperature of 78-80°F
- Aging:** Aged in oak barriques for 18 months, followed by 12 months bottle-ageing before release

Features and Benefits:

- Cecchi is one of the oldest and leading producers of Chianti, Chianti Classico, and Chianti Classico Riserva.
- Vineyard ownership allows Cecchi complete control over wine quality and allows Cecchi to produce both traditional and progressive wine styles.
- Cecchi has invested in state-of-the-art winemaking and aging facilities, creating a distinct advantage over other Tuscan wineries.
