## 2013 COEVO by Cecchi

Established in 1893, Cecchi (pronounced *check-ee*) is one of the oldest and most prominent producers in Tuscany, pioneering the growth and development of the Sangiovese grape worldwide. Cecchi embodies Tuscan authenticity with an emphasis on innovation and sustainability, crafting wines that showcase the pure expressions of the family's vineyards.

COEVO means contemporary. COEVO by Cecchi was created to express timeless elegance, style and quality. COEVO is a Sangiovese-based blend rounded out with Bordeaux varietals. The grapes come from Cecchi's best vineyards in Chianti and Maremma, thereby marrying the past, present and future of Cecchi in Tuscany.

- Appellation:** Toscana IGT
- Varietals:** 60% Sangiovese, 20% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot
- Color:** Deep violet with orange hues
- Aroma:** Fresh and enveloping aromas of dark fruit, liquorice and spice
- Taste:** Layered depth, body and silky tannins with round, balanced flavors of black raspberry, plum, dark chocolate and spice
- Aging:** 18 months in barrique and tonneaux, followed by over 12 months in bottle before release

### Vineyards:

- Chianti: medium alkaline mixture
- Maremma: quartz sandstone

### Features and Benefits:

- Hand-picked from hillside vineyards 250 meters above sea level in Chianti, and 200 meters above sea level in Maremma
- The Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon come from Cecchi's vineyards in Castellina in Chianti. The Merlot and Petit Verdot come from Cecchi's vineyards in Maremma.
- Quality & Authenticity: Family-owned vineyards and winery since 1893. Cecchi is an established and renowned brand globally.
