- Varietals:** 90% Sangiovese, 10% other red varietals
- Color:** Ruby red tending to garnet
- Aroma:** Bright, fruity, strawberry-infused aroma
- Taste:** Medium-bodied with silky tannins and a bright finish. Flavors of strawberry, raspberry and spice
- Vineyards:** Middle Dough alkaline soil composition. Elevation of 250 meters.
- Aging:** 12 months in wooden casks, minimum two months in bottle before release
