Varietals: 90% Sangiovese, 10% other grape varieties

Color: Ruby red with violet reflections

Taste: Medium-bodied and ready-to-drink now. Fruit-forward flavors of cherry and red fruits with fresh but firm structure

Vineyards: Alkaline mixed soil composition. Elevation of 250 meters.

Aging: Minimum two months
