Grapes for the 2012 Flor de Campo were selected from our outstanding cool climate vineyards in Santa Barbara County, including Sanford's La Rinconada estate vineyard, to highlight the quality of this appellation. This Chardonnay has aromas of tropical fruits with pineapple and citrus, with hints of vanilla and cream. This new release has nice acidity to keep it lively on the palate. This versatile Chardonnay is a nice complement to seafood and lighter dishes.
