

2007 Bismark Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon

Hanna's Bismark Mountain Ranch is high above the City of Sonoma and San Pablo Bay. The climate is windy and surprisingly cool which produces grapes with intense, deeply concentrated flavor. The unique terroir is both fierce and alluring. The 2007 Season marked a return to near normalcy after the remarkably challenging 2006 vintage. A dry winter and spring were followed by moderate June and July and early August. Frost was absent, and as a result we entered summer with very dry ground. A relatively warm summers and an August heat spike resulted in an early harvest for vintage 2007. Overall, the fruit was evenly ripened and very clean.

Appellation: Sonoma Valley

Varietals: 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Malbec, 7% Cabernet Franc, 1% Merlot

Color: Saturated purple

Aroma: Gilled sausage, sage and espresso. Then opens into notes of tobacco, black liquorice, and blackberry.

Taste: Entry is juicy, with a concord like freshness and flavors of plum, berry cobbler, nutmeg and olive tapenade. Finishes with a fine polish of grape tannin.

Fermentation: 5-12 days of skin contact. 100% malolactic fermentation.

Aging: 30 months in 25% new French oak and 50% new American oak barrels.

Alcohol: 14.4%
