The majority of the grapes for this wine are from the Sweetwater Vineyard. The balance is from our many different vineyard sites, including the new planting of West Block. The wine possesses typical Rochioli character and classic Russian River Valley charm with black cherry and spice aromas. Aged in French oak for 15 months, this wine displays a full body and silky texture finish, with a firm and balanced structure.

Aroma: Ripe cherry, vanilla and a hint of savory herbs.

Taste: Juicy and refined on the palate. A rich, concentrated mouthfeel with silky tannins and a long finish.
