



# 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

## Columbia Valley, Washington

Tangley Oaks 2013 Columbia Valley Cabernet Sauvignon Lot #17 is predominantly from three vineyard sites within the Columbia Valley (34%) and Wahluke Slope (66%) wine regions of Washington State. The Wahluke Slope AVA is an exemplary sub-appellation of the Columbia Valley and is carving out a reputation for big, bold wines rich in flavor and body. This community is known for producing very approachable red wines of quality and value.

Variety: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Color: Dark garnet

Aroma: Complex layers of black cherry, blackberry, cassis and mocha with a hint of dried herbs.

Taste: Structured and elegant, offering red fruit flavors, plush black currant, subtle spice and a hint of cocoa.

Fermentation: 10 days on the skins, pumpovers twice a day.

Aging: 15 months aging in 40% new French Oak.

Alcohol: 13.9%
