

## Grappa Monovitigno Prosecco

The pomace, collected when it is fresh and soft, is selected from Prosecco grapes. “Monovitigno” is a Nonino trademarked term denoting single varietal Grappa.

<b>Vineyard:</b>	Veneto, Italy
<b>Grapes:</b>	Prosecco
<b>Color:</b>	Clear
<b>Aroma:</b>	Scents of fresh acacia flowers
<b>Taste:</b>	Flavors of almond and green apple
<b>Aging:</b>	From six months to one year in stainless steel containers

### Features

- Nonino selects and collects pomace from its neighboring wineries immediately after pressing, when it is fresh and soft. This allows for a higher-quality grappa that acutely reflects the natural essence of the original grape from which it is distilled.
- Artisanal batch distillation and small production keeps the level of quality and care very high for all Nonino products.

- Nonino Distillery was established in 1897, and is still family owned and operated today by Giannola and Benito Nonino, and their three daughters: Cristina, Antonella and Elisabetta.
