2009 Devils' Peak

"Peak Series" of wines of Napa Valley Bordeaux blends were born to honor some grand crus of Bordeaux. Devils' Peak is the second blend in the series, following the traditions and methods of the St. Émilion region, which is dominated by Cabernet Franc, some Merlot and a small amount of Cabernet Sauvignon. This is a multi-faceted wine, with vibrant acidity and understated spices.

Appellation: Napa Valley

Varietals: 50% Cabernet Franc, 38% Merlot, 7% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

Color: Ruby red

Aroma: Blueberry and floral notes with hints of jasmine tea.

Taste: Firm, with a mix of spice, fresh-turned earth, dried berry and sage. Maintains focus and fine balance, ending with crushed rock and tobacco.

Fermentation: Each vineyard block is vinified separately. Like the traditional method in Bordeaux, the wines are assessed in January with final blending done in March.

Aging: Aged in French oak barrels, 50% new, in our underground wine caves for 22 months.

Alcohol: 14.2%
