2013 Chardonnay

Chardonnay from the Russian River Valley is finely structured wines that carry their rich fruit with grace, like the great Burgundy wines the Terlatos know so well. Burgundian clones, early-morning hand-harvesting, whole-cluster pressing – everything is pointed toward making a wine of lively fruit with a core of minerality. This wine is an authentic expressions of Russian River Valley and is created with the intention of serving gastronomy.

Appellation:	Russian River Valley
Varietals:	100% Chardonnay
Color:	Light gold
Aroma:	Apple pie spices (cinnamon and clove), Granny Smith apple, stone fruit (apricot and white peach).
Taste:	Briny minerality comes to the fore on this earthy, herbal Chardonnay, which is full and creamy at first sip. Smooth and easily enjoyable, it finishes with polished notes of oak and caramel.
Fermentation:	Barrel fermented in French oak for an average of 12 days.
Aging:	Aged for 9 months in French oak barrels, 20% new.
Alcohol:	14.2%
