- Color:** Light gold
- Aroma:** Bright aromas of white peach, pear and spring flowers

- Vineyards:** 15-25 years old, planted at 4,500 vines/hectare. Hand harvested in whole clusters.
- Fermentation:** Fermented in stainless steel tanks with select neutral yeasts to enhance freshness, varietal aromas and drinkability.
- Aging:** 6-8 months on the yeast with weekly battonage for enhanced texture.
- Alcohol:** 13%
