Varietals: 100% Chardonnay

Color: Golden

Aroma: Lemon curd, pear and cinnamon/clove spiciness

Taste: Good entrance with a rich mouth feel and long, lingering finish

Fermentation: Malolactic fermentations occur post-primary fermentation. The lees are stirred through malolactic fermentation, and the wine is aged sur lies until blending.

Aging: 35% new oak is primarily American and Hungarian oak, with a little bit of French. The Hungarian oak mimics French with Spicy character and the American rounds it out with a sweeter finish

Production: 8,000 cases
