- Varietals:** 100% Chardonnay
- Color:** Golden yellow

- Fermentation:** Malolactic fermentations occur post-primary fermentation. The lees are stirred throughout malolactic fermentation, giving the wine it's rich mouthfeel. Aging continues on the lees until blending.
- Aging:** 35% new oak is primarily American and Hungarian, with a small percentage of French. Hungarian oak mimics French with Spicy character and the American rounds it out with softly sweet vanillin's.
