Samantha's Garden reflects the unique terroir of Clare Valley characterized by bright lively aromas, subtle fruit flavors and fine grained tannins. This wine is named after Michael Twelftree's wife Samantha.

Varietals:	100% Shiraz
Color:	Black core, magenta rim
Aroma:	Red/black fruits with earthy aromas including eucalypt, cloves, spice and lifted chocolate notes. As always, the aromas are interesting and ever evolving in the glass.
Taste:	Dense, but fine fruit profile through the palate; plums, spice, bitter chocolate and subtle eucalypt notes with fine long tannins.
Aging:	20 months in one and two year old French oak hogsheads.
Alcohol:	14.8%
